Shade Gardening: Plants and Techniques

In this presentation, Sherri will discuss the advantages and challenges of gardening in the shade. Sherri will discuss different conditions of shade, from dappled shade to dense shade. She'll show examples of plants that can thrive in each condition. Sherri will point out techniques for dealing with competing tree roots, and irrigation scheduling for plants growing under trees, in addition to irrigation needs of plants growing under eaves and against building walls.
