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RELEASE AND HOLD-HARMLESS AGREEMENT

In consideration for being allowed to enter and/or participate in the Jackson County Master Gardener™ Association (also known as JCMGA) 2019 SPRING GARDEN FAIR and the services that JCMGA is providing to me in connection with its JCMGA 2019 SPRING GARDEN FAIR – SATURDAY & SUNDAY, May 4-5, 2019 (set up as scheduled May 2-3), and as an adjunct to and part of any vendor agreement relating to my presence or participation in the JCMGA 2019 SPRING GARDEN FAIR, I release JCMGA, its agents, employees, volunteers, and assignees (the “protected parties”), and agree to hold them harmless from any and all potential or actual liability relating to my participation or presence at the JCMGA 2019 SPRING GARDEN FAIR, including from their own negligence or fault, and assume all liability from any cause whatsoever relating to, arising out of, or otherwise connected with the participation in or presence at the JCMGA 2019 SPRING GARDEN FAIR, of me or any of my employees/employer, agents, helpers, and guests, including, but not limited to, all liability from any cause whatsoever for personal injury or property damage, as well as for contribution or indemnification. The protection of this agreement extends, but is not limited to, any and all contractual liability JCMGA may have for tort damages to the owner of the fair premises.

I release and hold harmless the JCMGA; its employees, agents, volunteers, assigns, and successors, (the “protected parties”) from all liability from any cause, whatsoever, in connection with such JCMGA 2019 SPRING GARDEN FAIR.

I assume all liability that existed at the time of the execution of this document and all liability that accrues from that time forward into the future.

I release and agree to hold harmless and agree to fully and diligently defend the protected parties at my sole expense from any and all alleged liability from any person or cause, whatsoever, which may allegedly have existed at the time of execution of this document or which may allegedly accrue afterward. In any such defense, the protected parties shall have the right to choose the counsel I employ to defend them.

This agreement shall be given a liberal construction to accomplish its protective purposes such that all ambiguities are resolved in favor of the protected parties. If any provision of this agreement is deemed to be partially void, invalid, or unenforceable, that provision shall continue in full force and effect to the maximum extent permitted by law and all remaining provisions of this document shall continue in full force and effect. To the extent that any provision of the agreement is deemed to be completely void, invalid or unenforceable, that provision shall be severed from the remainder of this agreement and all otherwise valid or enforceable provisions of this agreement shall continue in full force and effect.
