Discover the Vegetable Garden

The new vegetable garden is taking the place of the Children's Garden. The new garden's concept is to demonstrate various methods for small home vegetable gardens. Methods will include growing vegetables in strawbales, growing potatoes in very small areas (less than 3 square feet), companion planting and various cool and warm cover crops to be used in carbon sequestration, weed control as well as nitrogen fixing. Of course it will have the regulars such as bouquets of pollinator plants and hopefully a bountiful harvest of vegetables: carrots, radishes, onions, squash, potatoes, peppers, tomatoes and tomatillos, just to name a few.

Look for:

- ξ Biodiversity of vegetables and raised beds of various types of vegetables all together

- ξ Look for pollinators and diverse cover crops which aid in carbon sequestration and regenerative farming

- ξ Companion planting supports enhanced flavors in many harvested vegetables
- ξ Unique and experimental gardening techniques like growing potatoes in boxes and using strawbales for vegetable propagation
