LOOK FOR:

The lovely rock garden nestled under the Red Maple highlights some beautiful specimens, plus miniature plant varieties, ferns, and select perennials that require good drainage.

The shrub that looks like Poison Oak. It is not Poison Oak, but is actually its cousin, *Rhus aromatica*, a drought-tolerant native that has outstanding red fall color and small red berries.

The small water feature - a simple blue ceramic dish. This fun addition to the garden will attract a variety of wildlife.
