The Native Plants Garden

Plants naturally adapted to thrive with lower maintenance

LOOK FOR:

Oregon Grape *Berberis aquifolium*: It is Oregon's state flower and has shiny, spiked leaves, bright yellow flowers, and blue/purple berries. The berries are "edible" but very tart!

Western Columbine Aguilegia formosa: The very unusual orange flowers, which bloom in spring and early summer, are important nectar plants for hummingbirds.

Additional native plants are found in several of our other demonstration gardens. Many are deer-resistant, while providing food and shelter for a variety of native wildlife.

NOTES:

The Native Plants Garden showcases native trees and shrubs found in the Klamath-Siskiyou ecoregion.

Native plants are adapted to local soil conditions and climate, and thus are a good choice for low-water and low-maintenance landscaping.
