*Where Master Gardeners learn how to propagate*

## LOOK FOR:

**Our modified frame tents**, which conserve moisture and protect cuttings from drying out, while allowing for roots to set.

**Mother plants in the southwest corner.** These are the mature plants we use for cuttings. We track varieties to see which do well in Southern Oregon.

**A variety of ornamental plants**, shrubs, and fig trees that are offered for sale throughout the year.

## NOTES:



Flowers, shrubs, and trees can be propagated by rooting cuttings from parent plants.

This garden features the first registered hybrid rose grown in the United States, called *New Dawn*. This climbing rose has pink flowers.
