*You'll find techniques on pruning, trellising, and training*

## LOOK FOR:

**Wine grapes from the Rhone region** of France trained without trellis and spur-pruned: 'Mourvedre', 'Grenache', 'Syrah', and 'Viognier.'

**Wine grapes from the Bordeaux region** of France trained on a high quadrilateral cordon trellis and spur-pruned: 'Cabernet Sauvignon', 'Cabernet franc', 'Merlot', and 'Sauvignon blanc.'

**Raisin and table grapes** trained on open gable trellis (either spur- or cane-pruned): 'Thompson Seedless' (cultivated as either raisin or table grape), 'Sunpreme' (only vines in Oregon), 'Flame Seedless', and 'Autumn Royal.'

## GARDEN TIPS:



Prune vines during the winter, but in frost-prone areas, delay pruning to prevent early budbreak.

Fertilize established vines twice during the growing season.

Irrigate as needed. Two clusters require about 4-5' of shoot length to ripen properly.
